

FINAL VOTES – CHESTERFIELD SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
September 16, 2020

I certify that a legally called Town Meeting of the qualified voters of the Town of Chesterfield was held on Wednesday September 16, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm, which time a quorum was present. The following business was transacted:

ARTICLE 1: ARTICLE FAILED (22 NO, 19 YES) to transfer the sum of \$40,000 from Free Cash now in the Treasury to abate the asbestos and demolish the house and barn at 6 North Road; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2: VOTED UNANIMOUSLY to transfer the sum of \$4,000 from Free Cash now in the Treasury to compensate the Franklin Regional Council of Governments (FRCOG) for bidding and contracting services; or take any other action relative thereto.


Note: Hampshire Council of Governments performed these services prior to their closing and passed the cost along to the vendors instead of the Town. FRCOG assesses the Town based on population size.

ARTICLE 3: To take up any other matter which may legally be brought before this meeting.

ARTICLE 4: VOTED TO ADJOURN at 6:02pm. 46 voters attended the meeting, which is 5% of the 954 registered voters in Chesterfield.

This was our second meeting held outside, on the front yard at the New Hingham School located at 30 Smith Road. This was due to the Corona-19 virus. Attendees were required to wear face masks and seating was spaced at the required safe distancing.
